Dear Voters:

If you got this letter, you live in Alabama House District 37 and I'm asking you to just take a few minutes to read my explanation of why you should vote for me on November 6, 2018.

I am running to be your State Representative in Montgomery. What is a State Representative and what do they do?

State Representatives are elected members of Alabama's House Of Representatives whose job is to introduce and vote on bills — which later become State Laws. They oversee the state budget, work alongside the governor, and often oversee the drawing of legislative districts.

Right now, Alabama is under a REPUBLICAN TRIFECTA. This means that we have a Republican Governor, a Republican Super Majority in the Alabama Legislature; and an All-REPUBLICAN Court. IT IS NOT GOOD FOR ALABAMA TO HAVE SUCH AN IMBALANCE OF POWER IN GOVERNMENT. But the Republicans are fighting to keep it this way. Since the REPUBLICAN TRIFECTA came into power, our state NOW stands as one of the lowest ranking states in this country in economy, education, access to health care and overall quality of life.

On the flip-side, Alabama stands as one of the highest ranking states in poverty, infant mortality, obesity, diabetes, over-incarceration of minorities, the gap between the poorest and wealthiest citizens, and many other areas of life.

Who Are The Republicans?

They are a political party who won't tell you much about who they are, what they stand for or what they believe. But, if you listen to what they say, and how they vote, it becomes clear that they are NOT your friend. If you look at who makes up their party, it is obvious that they are not your friend. **Right now**, it is hard to say who they ARE. But, I can certainly tell you who they're NOT.
