NOTE: The Code of Alabama 1940, as amended in 1947, provides that the physical examination and blood test must be performed within 90 days before the date of application for marriage license. This certificate must be signed by a physician duly licensed to practice in Alabama or by a physician duly licensed to practice in other States. These certificates must be filed with the Judge of Probate before marriage license can be issued. Exceptions: In cases where an emergency exists the Judge of Probate is authorized and empowered to issue licenses without the certification as provided by law.
